IYST, January 31 – IYST Announces that SS Lazio Youth teams will compete against US Youth teams from California

From June 24 – July 8 2003 IYST will provide the opportunity for 3 teams from either San Francisco or San Diego to train, in Italy, with professional Italian coaches in preparation for a 2 day tournament with the SS Lazio Youth organization. The 15-day program has been designed to provide one of the greatest soccer experiences for young soccer players and teams.
